

Apollo Memorial Library (AML) Policy: Food and Beverage

BEVERAGES

Beverages in re-closable, spill-proof, plastic containers or plastic bottles may be brought into AML with the exception of alcoholic beverages. Beverages are not allowed near AML computer workstations, copy machines, genealogy area and tablet station area.

Approved containers include:

- Spill-proof mugs with secure lids and a drinking hole that can be closed
- Sports bottles with a drinking spout that can be closed
- Water in capped plastic water bottles

Containers not considered acceptable include:

- Open cups or mugs
- Aluminum cans
- Glass bottles
- Paper or Styrofoam cups with or without lids

Absolutely NO food or beverages are permitted in the areas of the computer workstations, copy machines, genealogy area, tablet station area or where prohibited by signs

In consideration of others, patrons are responsible to clean up after themselves.

Rationale

Food poses many risks to AML collections, equipment and furnishings. The most serious problems occur when food residue attracts pests or creates harmful conditions such as mold. AML appreciates your understanding and cooperation in assisting us in keeping our collections, equipment and furnishings in good working order.

The success of this policy depends on the patrons themselves to clean up spills that may have occurred.

Please report any spills to the AML Staff and place trash in appropriate containers.

Violators of this policy will be asked to leave the AML building.
